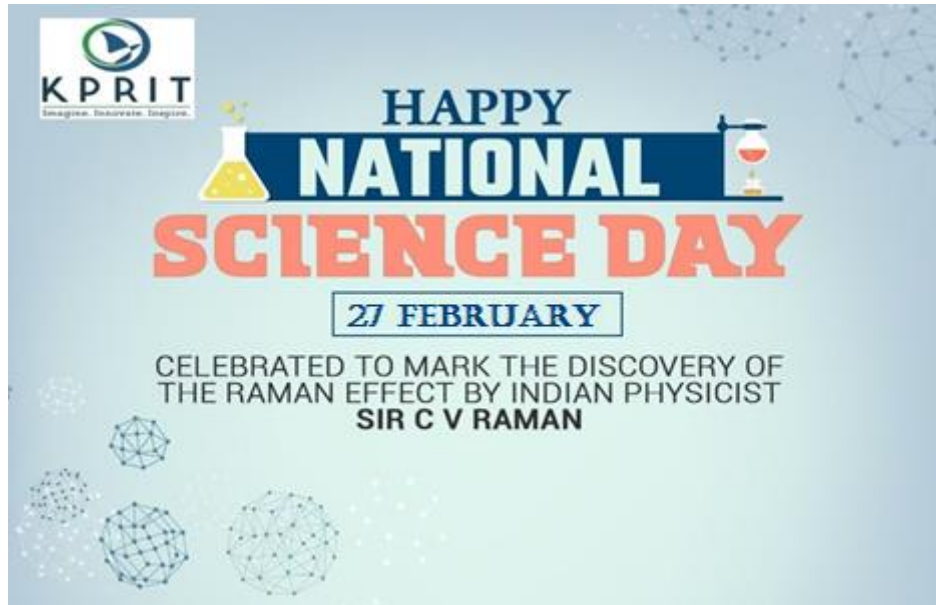
Traditional day

Independence Day Celebrations 2018

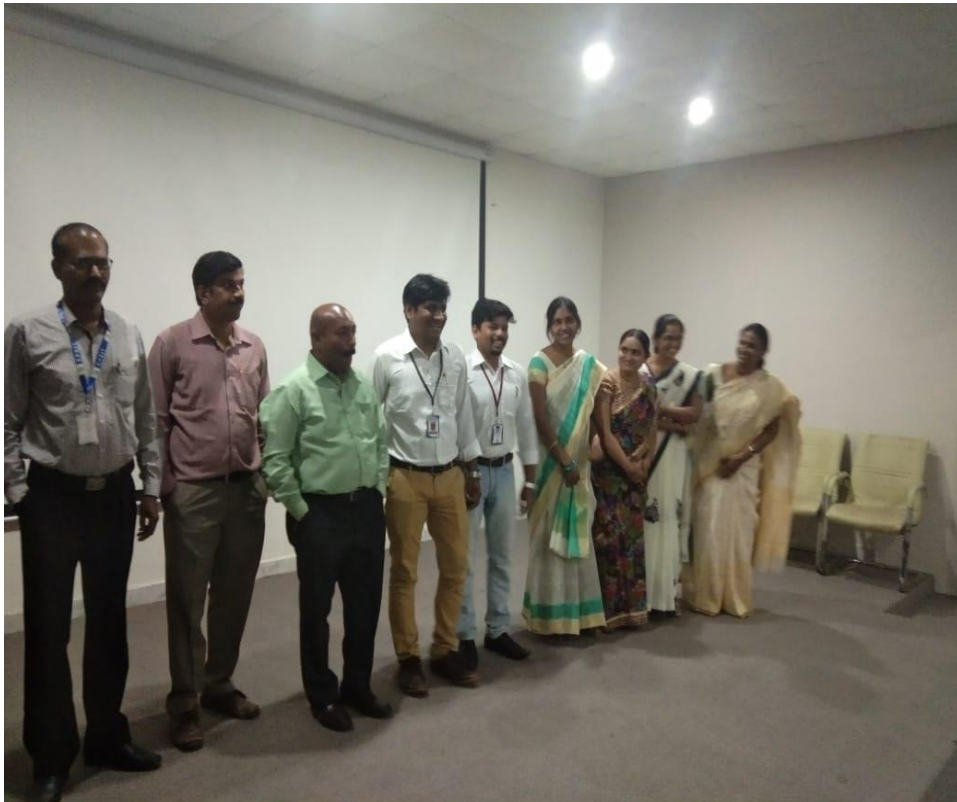

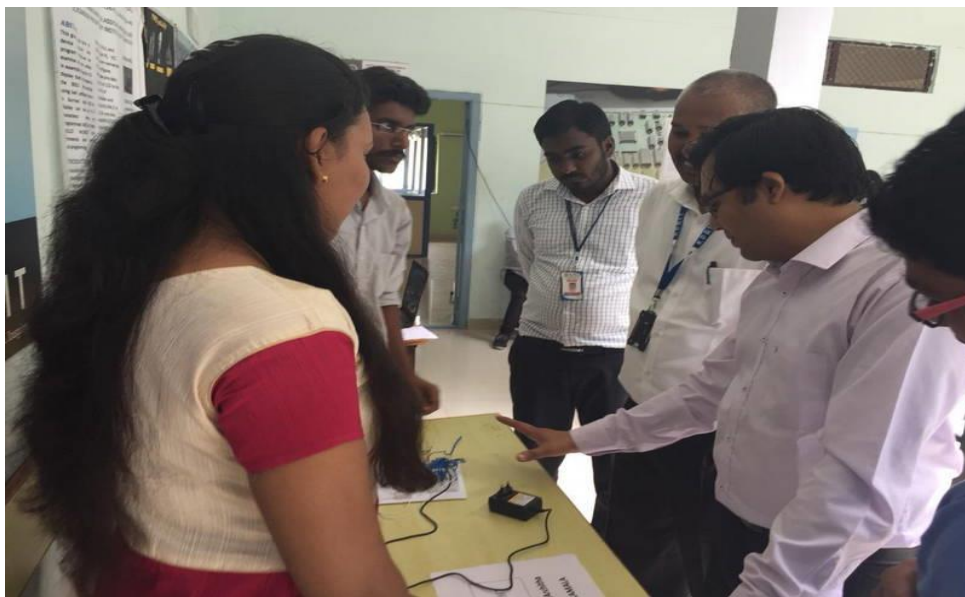

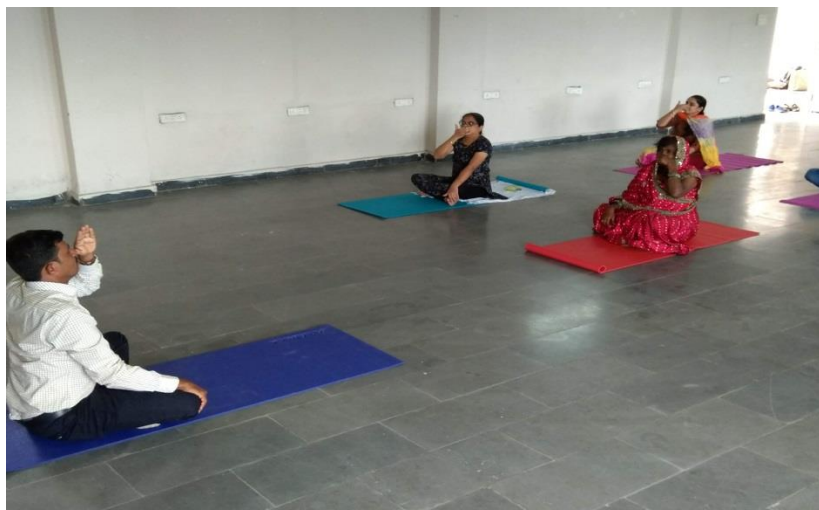
Women's Day 2019

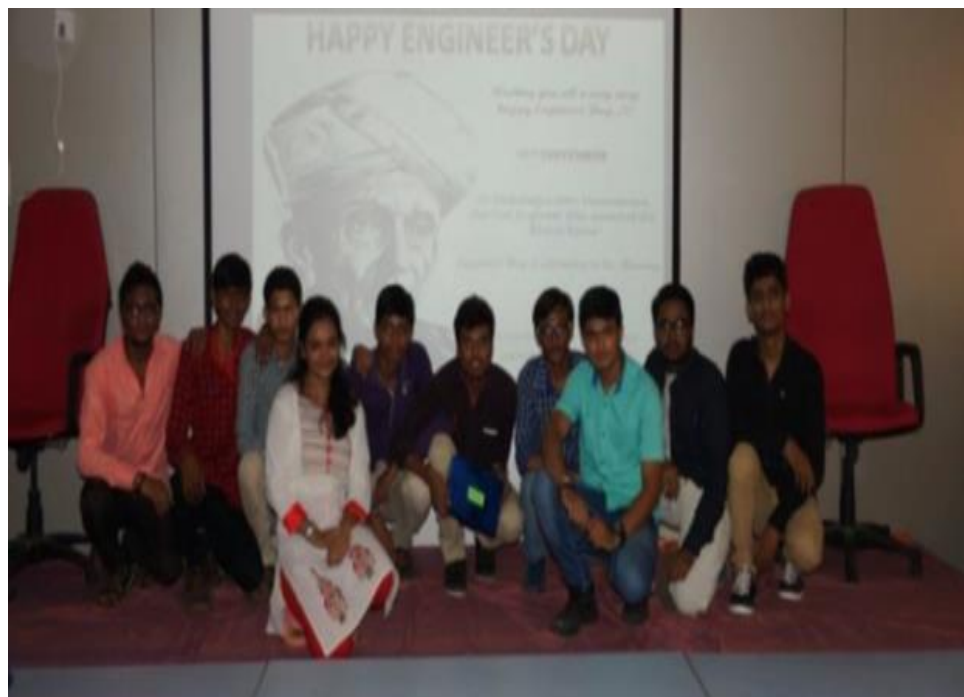
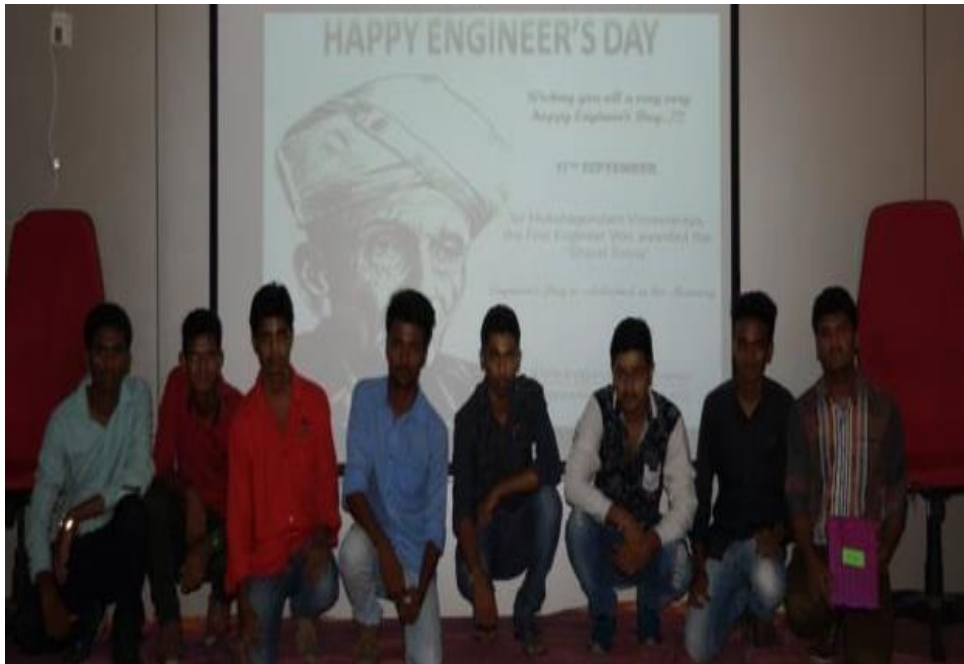
Teacher's day
